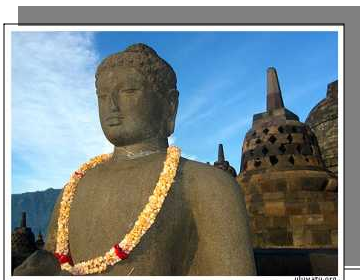
21st Century Theosophical Messengers and Society

Toward a Psychology for the 21st Century

Dr. Levy reviews mainstream scientific opinion which holds that all aspects of human mind and consciousness are generated by physical processes occurring in the brain. 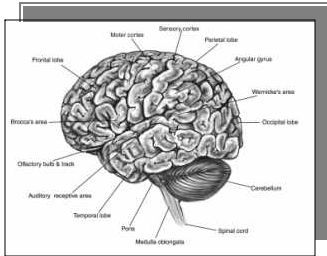

H. P. Blavatsky's Influences on Art and Culture

By all accounts, Af Klint was a sober, well-balanced woman. Her art and beliefs, however, were extreme. Regarded as a clairvoyant from childhood, she was a medium and one of Sweden's first followers of the theosophical teachings of Madame Blavatsky. Before she died, at the age of 81 in 1944, the Swedish artist Hilma af Klint stipulated that her paintings were not to be shown in public for 20 years after her death. Perhaps she felt that the world was not yet ready for them.

Neurofeedback and Brain Mapping: A New Paradigm of Consciousness and Healing

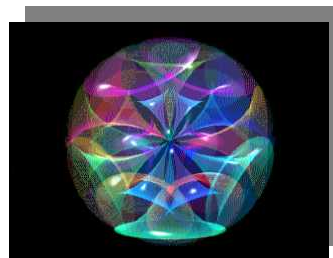

God, Science and The Secret Doctrine

Dr. Holmes is a clinical and forensic psychologist, and mystic scientist. His work explores the enigmas of human consciousness, the mysteries of the Heart, psychology as a science of the soul, the physics and metaphysics of creation and Zero Point dynamics. 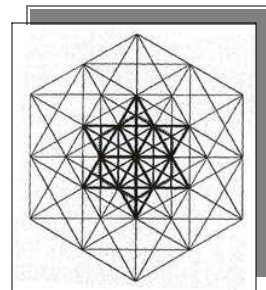
